Clifton All Saints Academy (CASA)



On the 20th June we were delighted to receive confirmation from the Regional Schools Commissioner that our Change of Age Range application was approved. The school's age range will be lowered from 4 years to 2 years. This means the Woodlands Pre-School will merge with Clifton All Saints Academy from the 1st September 2024. Clifton All Saints Academy is proud to offer pre-school provision for the first time and provide high quality education for children from the age of 2 to 11 years old.

As part of this work, the school has worked closely with Central Bedfordshire Council to secure in excess of £120,000 of funding to make much needed improvements to the current pre-school building both internally and externally. We have also worked closely with the Early Years Team at Central Bedfordshire Council and have secured further funding to provide the pre-school with completely refurbished resources and furniture in time for September. We are also very fortunate that the current pre-school staff are staying with us and becoming part of the Clifton All Saints team. If you are looking for pre-school provision, please get in touch with the school office school@cliftonallsaintsacademy.co.uk as we have spaces available for the September term.

As the end of term has approached, we have enjoyed a fabulous summer fayre hosted by our wonderful PTA. So many of our families and the local community visited us during the afternoon and helped raise vital funds for the school.

The Rev Canon Bill Ritson

Rector All Saints Church Clifton, 1969—1976

Every Anglican cathedral needs an influential figure behind the scenes who does not take things too seriously.

As canon residentiary, chaplain to four bishops for two decades and secretary to the Diocesan Pastoral Committee and Board of Ministry for many years, Bill Ritson pricked pomposity admirably at St Albans Cathedral.

The son of a churchwarden, he firmly resisted the complexities of the clerical mind that clog up diocesan committees. As such, his minutes and aides-memoir were often brilliant, if not hilarious, essays on life at the abbey and became keenly anticipated.

A lay listener remarked: “Bill’s simple and uncomplicated faith, in which fun plays a large part, appealed in a very direct way to many lay folk.” At one St Albans Abbey feast, where the guest was Nigel Hawthorne — no stranger to the church’s Trollopian absurdity having played the archdeacon Dr Grantly in a masterful 1982 BBC adaptation of *The Barchester Chronicles* — Ritson’s introduction almost stole the actor’s thunder. On another occasion, much enhanced by cushions, he would mimic senior clerics in the Church of England.

As a preacher Ritson gave sermons that were never longer than ten minutes, but would still be suffused with erudite references to films, novels and plays. When he retired there was standing room only at St Albans Abbey to wave him off.

In one address, given both in Cambridge and in London, he spoke of Ian Charleson, the star of the film *Chariots of Fire*, who played Eric Liddell, the Scottish runner who refused to compete on a Sunday and, after winning the 400m gold at the 1924 Olympics in Paris, became a missionary in China and died in a prisoner-of-war camp there in February 1945.

Ritson told the tragic tale of Charleson’s last performance as Hamlet in 1989 when aged only 40 and dying of Aids. “He said Shakespeare’s lines as if to encourage us all — a young actor frail and fragile at the very gate of death trying to encourage and affirm his fellow human beings: ‘Good night, sweet prince, and flights of angels sing thee to thy rest!’ ” Ritson saw that, through inspired acting, the words of Shakespeare could lead us to be lights of courage to others.

The Right Rev Peter Walker, while lecturing at Corpus Christi College, Cambridge, where Ritson studied, had noticed that Ritson was so self-effacing, never putting his goods in the shop window, that some dons had undervalued him. But when Ritson returned to preach at Corpus it was this outstanding sermon that connected with the contemporary life of the undergraduates.

Gerald Richard Stanley Ritson was born in Sunderland in 1935 to Gerald, a lawyer, and Violet (née Cowell), a domestic science teacher. He was educated at Durham School and read classics and theology at Corpus.

Bill, as he was known, came slowly to the decision to be ordained, influenced by his north-country parish, worship at Durham Cathedral and Walker, who perceived his gifts at Corpus. After two years of National Service in the army — during which he once demanded the name of the Archbishop of Canterbury from a group of late-night returning revellers as the barracks password — he trained for the priesthood at Lincoln Theological College. After being ordained in 1961 he served in various parishes in the diocese of St Albans before moving to the cathedral. Having cared for his elderly father, he demonstrated pastoral gifts of sensitivity and shrewdness, gently encouraging many young people who were considering a vocation to ministry.

In 2000 he retired to a small flat within sight of the stage door of the Old Vic on the aptly named Mitre Road in southeast London. Here, his guests, sleeping in his study, faced a 6ft pile of theatre programmes and, outside, passages lined with film and Broadway posters as well as bookshelves crammed with theology and plays.

He was invited to be an auxiliary priest at Southwark Cathedral by the dean, Colin Slee. Ritson also had special links with St Paul's, the actors' church in Covent Garden, and the Haymarket Theatre. He was a strong supporter of the ministry of women and alert to the need for down-to-earth catholic ecumenism. Ritson was always available and his warm smile and alert and probing questioning won friends wherever he was.

Widely read, he understood the questions and hesitations of many reflective English Christians. In later years he came out as gay and, in retirement, advised and mentored many young people who were struggling to find their identity.
