### England expected - knit your bit

Hand-knitting was at a peak in Britain in the 1940s. During the Second World War, women on the home front were encouraged to contribute to the war effort by knitting for the troops, which was promoted as public duty. Advertising at the time stated: "England expects - knit your bit".

Many knitting patterns were given away free, while wool was also sent to schools so that children could knit gloves, scarves and balaclava helmets for the forces. Wool was also supplied to organisations such as the Women's Institutes of England and Wales. who made over 22 million knitted garments for the Red Cross (an average of 67 garments per member). Parcels of their knitwear were sent to prisoners of war, as well as to troops.

We've made a great start to the new term, and there have already been several notable highlights.

The first was a Model United Nations event, for which we had the privilege of hosting nine schools from across Bedfordshire. Our students led and participated in a thought-provoking debate on the climate crisis and environmental sustainability. Each school sent four students to represent a different country, including China, Denmark, Brazil, and the USA. They spent the day making speeches, formulating alliances, and agreeing on a resolution.

We were also pleased to welcome PCC John Tizard, who joined us for a tour of the academy and was impressed by the initiatives and educational opportunities available to our students. By complete coincidence, we also welcomed the Chief Constable, Trevor Rodenhurst, on the same day to talk about how we can work together for the benefit of our students, including assemblies and talks on careers in the police and forensic science.

In the arts, auditions for our upcoming summer production of '9 to 5' have concluded, and I am confident this will be another memorable show. Additionally, our students are hard at work preparing for their exam drama performances scheduled for March. I look forward to seeing their talent and creativity come to life on stage.

In sports, we have already witnessed some outstanding accomplishments. Our U16 boys' rugby team triumphed in the latest round of the national cup, defeating Rugby School, the birthplace of the sport, in a remarkable last-minute victory. They made it through to the quarter-finals, where they will play NSB. Additionally, our U15 girls' netball team secured a place in the Sisters in Sports Bowl Semi-Final following an impressive 44-23 win in their last match.

I would like to extend my congratulations to our Sixth Form leadership team for their exceptional fundraising efforts recently. Their successful bake sales raised significant funds in support of Aaron, reflecting the strong spirit of community service and compassion that defines our academy.

### Three things this month...

1. Clifton Parish Council is mandated to have up to twelve Councillors. A Parish Council is the last tier of Government and is primarily tasked with providing some of the services needed within its Parish. It also liaises with the next tier, in our case Central Bedfordshire Council, to try to ensure they understand and meet those needs of Clifton for which they are responsible. Not an easy task in these financially challenging times!

Clifton is, one could argue, one of the more pro-active Parish Councils, and each Councillor contributes by using their knowledge and experience for the benefit of our village.

Unusually, we currently have two vacancies which have occurred in close succession and would like to fill them by co-option to help keep Clifton such a great place in which to live.

To qualify you must live in Clifton and have done so for at least one year.

So, if you feel you have a few hours to spare each month, are a team player and enjoy getting stuck in, please get in touch with the Parish Clerk. The contact details are below.

- 2. Now, although the Parish Council can draw upon a lot of knowledge and experience, there are some things we need help with. This month we are asking any residents if they are, or know someone who is, a qualified architect prepared to voluntarily help us work on what is for us, a fairly complicated project. If successful, this project would greatly improve the facilities we currently provide. For more information, again, please contact the Parish Clerk.
- 3. Finally, (we promise!), the "Adopt a Clifton Pathway" scheme is another Parish Council initiative designed to keep our lovely village, well, lovely. We have lots of volunteers who commit to keeping their street or any public area free of litter and they do a fantastic job. A couple of our volunteers have, inexplicably, moved out of Clifton! (They'll be sorry!). This, of course, has left us slightly short of help. If you feel you would like to get some fresh air and exercise and help the community at the same time, please get in touch with, you guessed it, the Parish Clerk.


