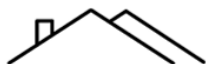

## OUR ACTIVITIES

Rather than regularly bend your ear about becoming a volunteer it's about time to give you some idea of the number and sort of requests the CGNS responds to over a period of time.

During the quarter April to June 2024 volunteers met:

- ✓ 88 requests for transport to hospital, GP surgeries and other health related appointments,
- ✓ 128 social and other transport requests. For example visiting loved ones in care homes and hospital, trips to the hairdressers, collecting prescriptions, shopping etc and also made
- ✓ 20 befriending calls or visits.

Over that same period there was only 2 calls we were unable to meet. The latter figure is one we find difficult but inevitably there will always be the odd occasion we can't help but we will continue to do our best.

These are simple statistics but nonetheless reveal a real commitment by volunteers to respond wherever possible to the needs of the local community.

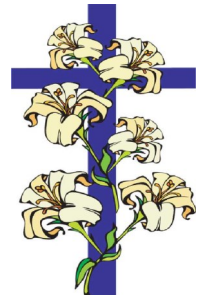


# Mary Morgan

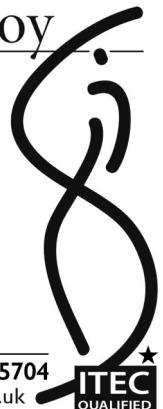

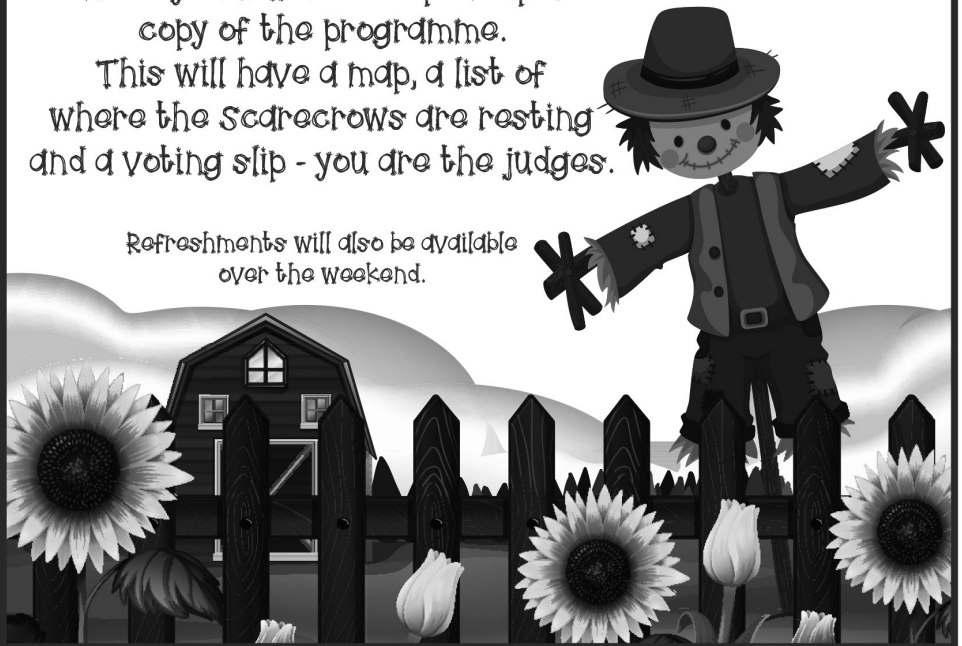

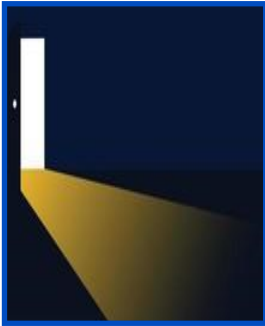

## Caring for God's Acre—Flowery Burial Grounds

People come to our village church to say goodbye to loved ones, to celebrate weddings and births, to look round the mediaeval building as well coming to regular services of course. All these people walk through our beautiful and welcoming churchyard which is maintained entirely by a voluntary team of dedicated and enthusiastic mowers and gardeners. We are very grateful that they serve the community in this way.

The churchyard is also part of our commitment as an Eco Church; we have a grass cutting regime which enhances the biodiversity of the area which is an example of unimproved grassland, a really rare habitat. So much so that we are currently waiting to hear if we qualify as a County Wildlife Site! We have enough key indicator species we just have to have enough of each one of them—fingers crossed.

At the recent visit of Judith, the Diocesan Adviser, and Dan from the Wildlife Trust it was also suggested that we also apply to have our churchyard included on a website called 'Flowery Burial Grounds' which is run by the Caring for God's Acre Charity—we made it! Star plants include a Pyramidal Orchid and Ivy Broomrape, I have to admit the Broomrape is not a plant of great beauty but it is really rare in Bedfordshire. ☺

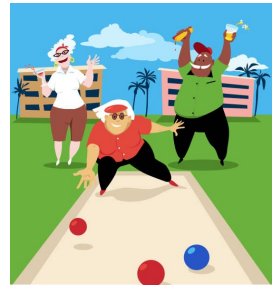
